The Meadows Claiming Procedure

Who May Claim: A current member or associate member of the United States Trotting Association or a current licensee of this or another jurisdiction may claim any horse in a claiming race if the member, associate member or licensee has on credit, with the association conducting the race, an amount equal to the specified claiming price. A person may file only one claim in one race.

What Is Required: Only Cashier Checks, Money Orders, Meadows RAcetrack Casino purse checks or Meadows Racetrack & Casino Claim Check from a previous claim will be accepted as funds for a claim at the Bookkeeper's office. Cash for a claim will be accepted in the mutuels area of the Casino and a voucher will be issued evidencing the deposit. The voucher must be submitted with the claim to the Bookkeeper. Also required will be the requisite fees for transfer of title. Transfer fee is \$35 which should be a personal check only made out to the U.S.T.A.

Where to Make Claims: All claims are made with the Horsemen's Bookkeeper located in the Race Office. Any questions regarding a claim are to be directed to the Judges. The Bookkeeper will not answer any questions.

When to Make Claims: Claims shall be in writing on forms and in envelopes provided by the association, sealed and deposited in the claim box at least 15 minutes before the time originally scheduled for the race to begin.
