## **PURPOSE**

To protect employees, vendors, horsemen, and visitors who work in or enter areas where there is a danger of foot injuries or hazards.

## **SCOPE**

Covers any employee, vendor, horseman, or visitor who performs work or enters an area considered to be conducive to foot injuries.

## EMPLOYEES, HORSEMEN, VISITORS, VENDORS

All persons performing any type of work in the Paddock are expected to wear footwear appropriate for the Paddock

Sandals or other open-toe style shoes are not permitted to be worn in the Paddock for those working with or in direct contact with the horses. Visitors with open-toe shoes or sandals will be permitted to enter the Paddock but will be advised of the potential danger of unsafe shoes in the Paddock and will be advised not to have direct contact with horses.
