AND NOW, this 26th day of July, 2017, in accordance with its general authority and jurisdiction over pari-mutuel racing activities and specifically, under the authority set forth in §9311(h) of the Racing Act (3 Pa. C.S. §9311(h)) to adopt temporary regulations, the Commission hereby approves the following provision governing the "re-drawing" of horses in overnight events and stakes races when an eligible horse has been mistakenly or inadvertently omitted from the draw. The Commission directs that this provision, as set forth in the attached Annex A, be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* as a temporary regulation as soon as possible.

PART VIII 7 Pa. Code, Chapter

(STANDARDBRED HORSE RACING)

Section 1. Re-draw of horses.

For all events, including, but not limited to overnight and stakes races, all drawings shall be final unless there is conclusive evidence that a properly declared horse, eligible at the time of entry, has been mistakenly omitted from the race through the error of the association, its agent or employee, in which case, the racing secretary shall immediately re-draw the race in question, provided, that the error is discovered prior to scratch time or the printing of the program whichever is sooner.
